BACKGROUND

In this role, Page also educates others on the inclusion of people with disabilities in mainstream society through instructional or video training. He has conducted training classes for Amtrak, the Baltimore Ravens, United Airlines, the American Bankers Association, the United States Holocaust Memorial Museum, the Kennedy Center for Performing Arts, the Florida Board of Civil Rights, the Election Center, International Association of Exposition Management, the State Board of Elections for North Carolina, Prospect Airport Services, AIRSERV, Transportation Security Administration, and multiple Paralyzed Veterans' chapters across the nation.

Page has represented Paralyzed Veterans in a number of capacities, including board positions on the National Barrier Awareness Foundation, the Amtrak Accessibility Advisory Board, the Baltimore Ravens Accessible Task Force, the Amtrak Customer Advisory Committee, the National Task Force for Accessible Elections, Consortium for Citizens with Disabilities Board of Directors,

Independence Center of Northern Virginia, the Leadership Conference on Civil Rights, and the Center for Excellence in Assistive Living.

Page continues to educate others on the inclusion of people with disabilities in mainstream of society through specialized instructional training gatherings. These have included sessions for Amtrak, the Baltimore Ravens, United Airlines, the American Bankers Association, the United States Holocaust Memorial Museum, the Kennedy Center for Performing Arts, the Florida Board of Civil Rights, the Election Center, International Association of Exposition Management, the State Board of Elections for North Carolina, Prospect Airport Services, AIRSERV, Transportation Security Administration (TSA); as well as multiple Paralyzed Veterans chapters and many others.
